



CHARLIE ELLINGTON is Professor of Animal Mechanics in the Department of Zoology at the University of Cambridge. His research is in the broad subject of biomechanics, and he has studied many aspects of animal flight in particular: aerodynamics, mechanics, energetics, physiology and behavioural ecology. In recognition of his work he was awarded the Scientific Medal of the Zoological Society of London in 1990 and elected FRS in 1998.
